The Program*

Khorde Rushen:

Khorde Rushen [Delineating Samsara and Nirvana] is the first level Dzongchen retreat of the cycle of Künzang Gondu and is only for those who accomplished at least 10'000 times the five preliminary practices of Künzang Gondu Ngöndro of Tertön Orgyen Pema Lingpa.

Bardo:

The Bardo Teachings is the fourth and last retreat of the cycle of Künzang Gondu. For those who have taken the retreats of Khorde Rushen, Trekchö and Thögal.

*Although both retreats will take place on the same dates and in the same place, you will only be allowed to attend one. The Khorde Rushen teachings will be taken in the mornings while the Bardo teachings will be taken in the afternoon.



The retreat will take place in the park *Zacatlan Adventure*.

Located in the state of Puebla, the Zacatlán region is known for its mist-drenched mountains, lush forests, beautiful waterfalls, fascinating trails and its picturesque town where its traditional crafts, impressive mosaic murals, tasty food and sweets apples amaze anyone.

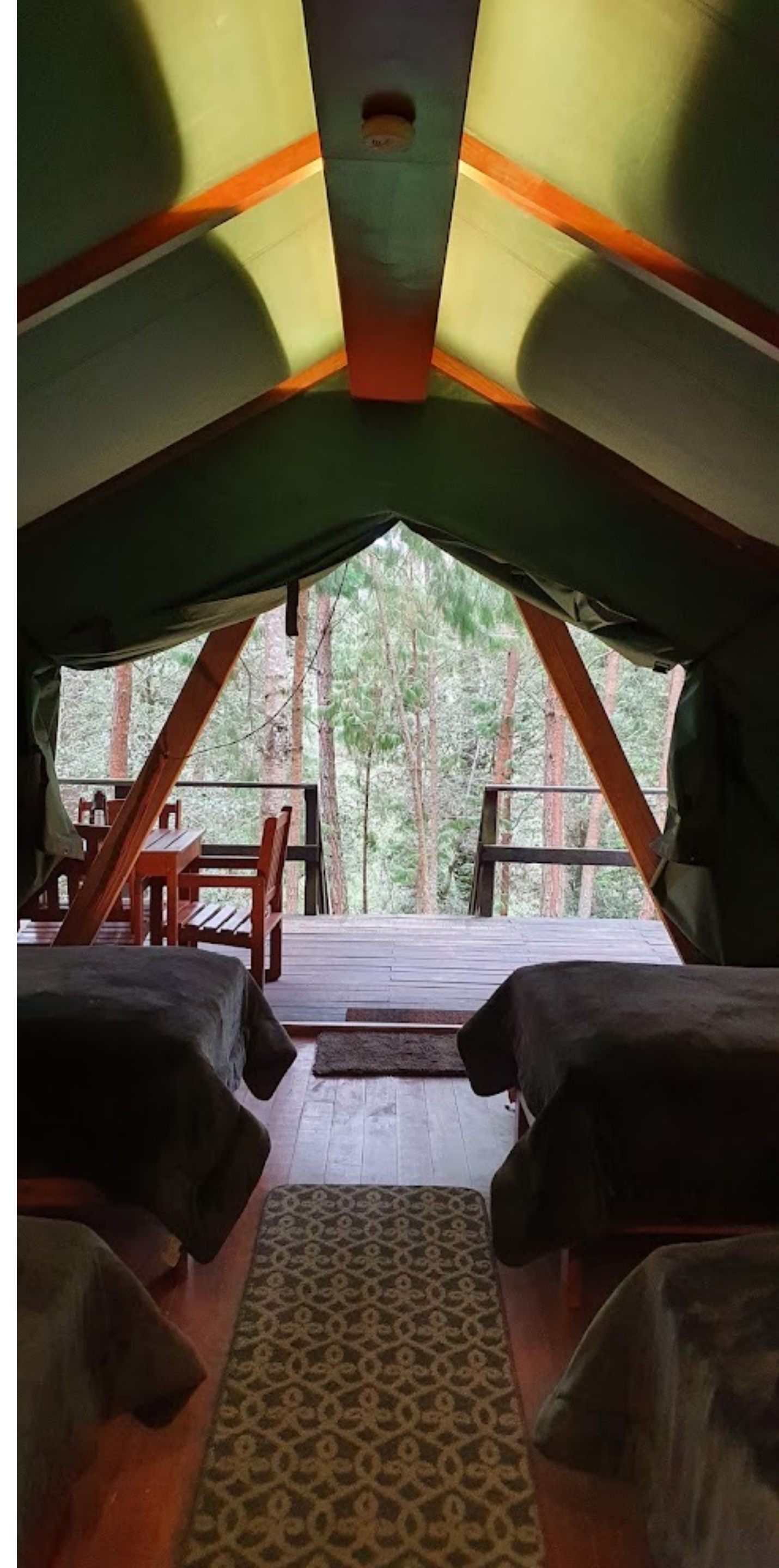

- Cabins for lodging
- Camping and Glamping Area
- The general hall where the Gompa will be
- Community dining room

Accommodation costs

- Deluxe room (1 person):

- King bed and a full bathroom

- 125 USD per night

- Double room (2 people):

- King bed and a full bathroom.

- 60 USD per night per person

- Triple room (3-4 people):

- Two single beds, a double bed and a full bathroom.

- 60 USD per person per night

- Glamping/ Glamour Camping (4 people):

- Spacious fixed tents, with 4 single beds and a bathroom

- 43 USD per person per night

Camping Area:

- You need to bring your own tent with rain gusset

- 15 places available

- The food will be in charge of a qualified chef who offers a varied, nutritious Buffet prepared with fresh foods three times a day plus coffee breaks.
